1. A buyer's premium will be added to the hammer price of each lot: The buyer's premium is 25% of the final bid.
2. All property is **SOLD "AS IS"**. Neither the auctioneer nor consignor makes any warranties or representations of any kind or responsible for the correctness, nor deemed to have made any representation or warranty, or description, genuineness, authorship, attribution, provenance, period, culture, source, origin, or condition of the property and no statement made at the sale, or in the bill of sale, or elsewhere shall be deemed such a warranty or representation or assumption of liability. Trinity does not guarantee authorship or signatures of paintings.
3. The highest bidder as determined by the auctioneer shall be the purchaser. In the case of a disputed bid, the auctioneer shall have sole discretion in determining the purchaser.
4. All merchandise purchased must be paid for and removed from the premises the day of the auction unless other arrangements have been made with our office. Trinity is not responsible for any items left on our premises after the auction has ended. All merchandise remaining in our building after seven (7) days of the auction (without arrangements made with our office) will be charged a storage fee of \$10.00 per item, per week, **without exception**. All storage fees must be paid in full before any items will be released.
5. Personal and Business checks will be acceptable only if credit has been established with Trinity, or if a bank authorization has been received (on bank letterhead) guaranteeing a check. Trinity reserves the right to hold merchandise purchased by check for ten business days to ensure that the check has cleared the bank if such action is deemed necessary to protect its interest. Makers of bad checks will be fully prosecuted of the law.
6. All purchases are subject to Sales Tax applicable to the buyer's designated address. If you have a resale certificate, you must complete a Sales & Use Tax Resale Certificate, prior to making payment, for tax to be removed from your invoice.
7. Bidders should personally examine each lot on which they will be bidding, in order to determine condition, size, and restoration or repair. All items are sold as-is and where-is. Trinity International Auctions, LLC. disclaims any express or implied warranties or guarantees as to the authenticity, age or date, condition, merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, correctness of the catalog or supplemental material, or other description of the physical condition, size, quality, rarity, importance, medium, provenance, exhibitions, literature or historical relevance of any property. The letter must be signed, and on letterhead of the recognized expert or authority. Any exceptions to this rule must be specifically approved by TIA. We do not recognize the opinion of any auction house or its employees as an expert opinion. 5. The prospective buyer must complete and sign a registration form before bidding. Auctioneer shall have sole discretion on when any item may be sold or re-sold at any time during or after any auction.
